**Definitions:**

**Brit Chadashah** is a combination of 2 Hebrew words that mean New (*Renewed*) Covenant (*New Testament*)

**Chagim** is a Hebrew word that means Feast or Festival Days (*Holidays*)

**Haftorah** is the portion of scripture read after the weekly Torah Parsha reading and is always taken from one of the books written by the Prophets

**Parsha** is the Hebrew word that means "portion" it's used to describe the weekly Torah Portion to be read

**Parashah** is the plural form of the Hebrew word parsha - so this Torah Cycle is a list of all the parashah that will be read on a weekly basis as we study the scriptures

**Torah** is the Hebrew word used to describe the 1st five books of the Bible. It literally means "instructions" (*not "law"*) & refers to the instructions given by God to Israel
